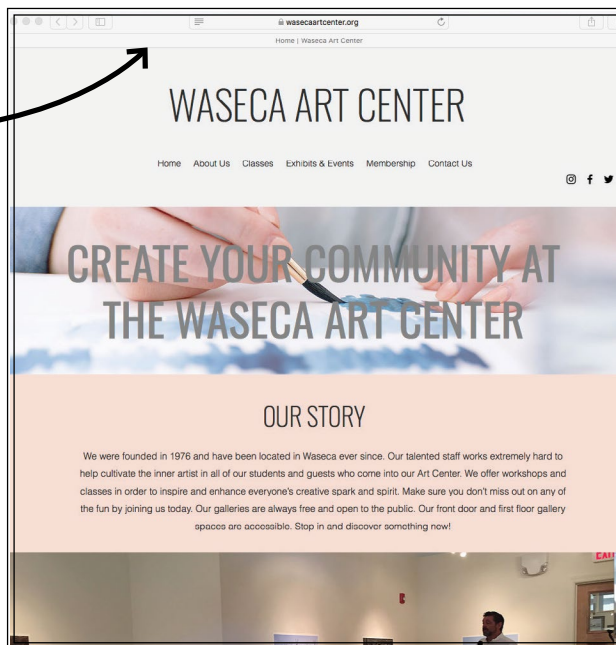

2019 Education schedule in separate document //

Educational: Karen Krause continues to teach the Make & Take Classes for age group K – 3rd and Club Picasso for age group 4 – 8. Summer Art Camp for age group K – 8 were held in June. WAC hosted a few Early Out classes this year along with several other classes for students and adults.

Missy Donner, Jess Stuckmayer and Andrew Breck were additional instructors throughout the year.

Classes continue to be published and processed through Community Ed. *It would be beneficial for WAC to increase art opportunities and art related classes taught by qualified instructors.*

Picture Person Parade (PPP) Art Appreciation Series: was in use at Sacred Heart School, WEM schools, and Janesville Trinity. The Picture Parade also goes to the senior living center, Colony Court in Waseca. *The ED would like to add additional schools to this list in the 2020/2021 school year; it is our goal to update the process and organization of the PPP.*

Adult Drawing Group and Art Appreciation group meets weekly throughout the year, we updated the name to the Art Adventurer’s to begin marketing the diverse activities this group does. *This free educational opportunity accounts for over 40 of the 53 adult classes, or 75%, offered in 2019.*

Spring Concert Series:

Three concerts of varying music genres including jazz, rock and heritage folk music were featured in 2019 in the Schultz Auditorium, which also received heating and cooling units that allow us to control temperature year round. *This organization may benefit from recruiting 2 well known talent acts within two different age demographics divided by requested grant money; this may cost more but would result in requesting a higher ticket price point that could also be used to pay for performers. Proceeds of both could go to a third act.*

Community Outreach:

Speaking: In 2019 ED, Andrew Breck visited Rotary Club, and Exchange Club to speak with community members about the Art Center’s mission, Career Navigation Day at the SCC Faribault campus and spoke with 9th graders from Waseca, Medford and NRHEG about career opportunities in art and highlighted WAC, met and spoke with Waseca High School Choir and several art classes.

Art Outreach: We held three - day session paper making workshop over the course of 3 week at *Colony Court* and served more than a dozen senior citizens with the assistance of over a half dozen volunteers from all ages.

The Art Center also participated in the *Waseca Water Carnival* - a collaboration with Waseca Public Library, Water Park, Community Ed to name a few organizations; Five classes from 2nd grade Hartley Elementary visited our galleries; WAC hosted a workshop people with developmental disabilities from ICAN and their art was exhibited in the Great Hall Gallery; WAC hosted a book reading and signing for Cow Tipping Press, a regional NPO that holds neurodiverse workshops for people with developmental disabilities and publishes their poems and stories; 6x6 artwork part was held for a fundraiser and was well attended; WAC continues to host a monthly Cultural Ambassadors meeting for Farmamerica, Waseca County Historical Society, Chamber of Commerce, Waseca Public Library, Waseca Waterpark, and Community Ed.

Events: WAC participated in Treats on the Streets; *Waseca Winter Wonderlights* window display contest, opened our doors to the Sleigh and Cutter Parade - temperatures during the parade this year was around (-5) degrees below zero, fahrenheit; WAC held over a dozen free art workshops for people of all ages, and demographics from our community in our storefront which were possible from a grant by the Waseca Area Foundation - Al Volbrecht Arts and Cultural Fund; WAC had two book reading/signings by two local authors; WAC hosted Cow Tipping Press / book launch and author reading from people with developmental disabilities.

Staffing: From May of 2017 - January of 2019, Rachel James the WAC Executive Director and Andrew Breck was the Administrative Assistant. Andrew Breck became the Interim Executive Director in February 2019 and became the Executive Director in August. Amanda Larkin was hired as the Gallery Assistant in April and is still in that position. GAC graduate Miranda Shaffer was hired for a transition period from May - September as Programs Coordinator. *WAC is now looking to hire an Office Manager.*

Gift Shop: In 2017 WAC implemented a policy change which omitted stock inventory and went to solely consignment. *After scouting other specialty shops and conversing with the President and Treasurer of the board - it would be beneficial for WAC to shift gift shop inventory to lower price point items that would be specific to our area and the Art Center. Waseca specific postcards and notecards, ceramic mugs, prints etc.*

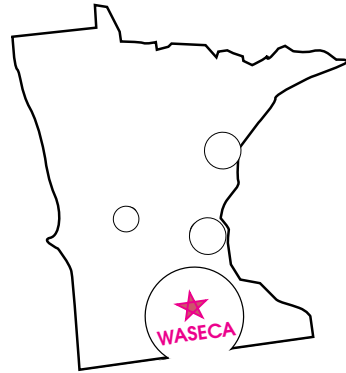

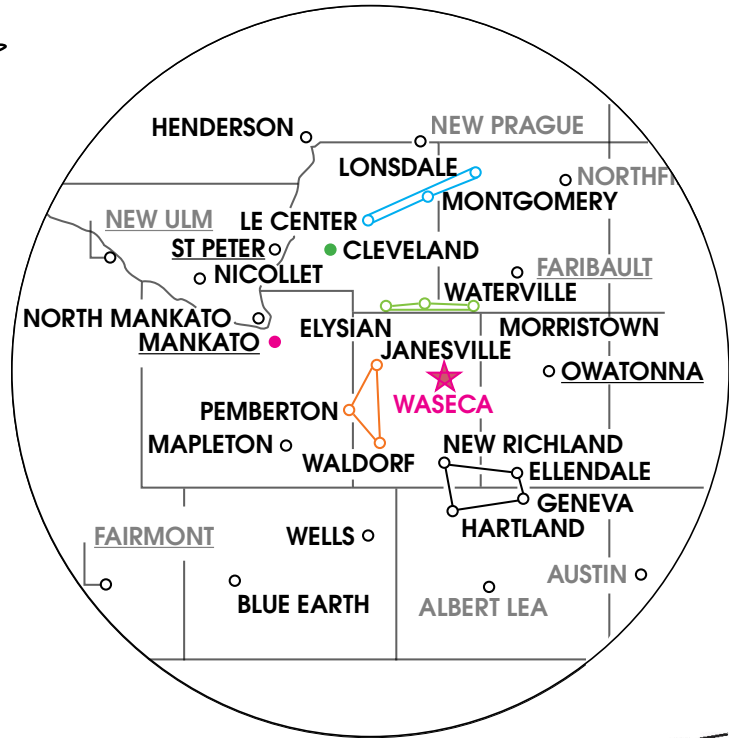
